Response to your request for official information

Thank you for your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) to Manatū Hauora (the Ministry of Health) on 29 October 2022 for information relating to natural health products (NHPs).

Before I respond to each part of your request below, please accept our apologies for the delay in responding to your request. Your queries were treated as part of correspondence relating to the NHP hui on 1 and 3 November 2022, until it was pointed out that the request was for official information and should therefore be considered in accordance with the Act. The team had prioritised work required for introduction of the Therapeutic Products Bill into the House before responding to queries relating to the NHP hui.

What adverse reactions data from Australia and other international recall data does the Ministry of Health hold?

There is a large amount of information relating to this part of your request which is publicly available. A number of agencies in various countries provide information to the public about reported and suspected adverse reactions to medicines, including natural health products. I refer you to some of the publicly available information below:

Australia's Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA) has provided Manatū Hauora the following information for public release:

"To November 2022, the TGA has received over 8000 adverse event (AE) reports associated with complementary medicines (CM) dating back to 1994. Of these, approximately:

- 28% relate to vitamins, minerals or vitamin/mineral combination products
- 24% relate to multi-ingredient products that include herbal ingredient(s)

- 19% relate to herbal medicines
- 9% relate to other multi-ingredient products with no herbal ingredients
- 2% relate to Traditional Chinese Medicines (TCMs) or Ayurvedic medicines.

The remainder related to other CM types. TGA notes that it can be difficult to categorise some CM types, and that some products may fit into multiple categories. In addition, some reports involve multiple suspected medicines which may include more than one CM type, or a mix of CM and OTC or prescription medicines."

Please note, information collected through the spontaneous reporting systems mentioned above is used to detect safety signals, not measure the degree of harm associated with any particular medicine or medicine type. There are a number of caveats to this data, which are explained with the released information. Manatū Hauora has other international data, however this data is withheld in full under section 6(b)(ii) of the Act, as its release would prejudice information entrusted to the Government of New Zealand on a basis of confidence by any international organisation.

There are also numerous scientific publications and textbooks available to the public. For instance, in the USA, a Centers for Disease Control and Prevention study estimated that approximately 23,000 emergency department visits and more than 2000 hospitalisations each year are attributed to adverse effects of dietary supplements. Other investigators reported that the incidence of liver failure related to dietary supplements increased by a factor of 8 between the passage of the law currently governing these products, the Dietary Supplement Health and Education Act of 1994 (DSHEA), and 2021.

What data does the MOH hold that New Zealand NHP products result in harm?

In New Zealand, the Centre for Adverse Reaction Monitoring (CARM) collects, evaluates, and analyses spontaneous reports of adverse reactions to medicines and vaccines, herbal products and dietary supplements used in New Zealand. Further information about CARM is publicly available at: https://nzphvc.otago.ac.nz/carm/.

Evidence of harm is not the same as reports of suspected adverse reactions. The word 'harm' implies some kind of injury and that someone has less of something (eg, health). In contrast, a report to CARM relates only to a suspicion of an adverse reaction. It may not actually be related to the product taken and may be for something that doesn't cause 'harm', such as a headache from which the person totally recovers.

Reports received by CARM are submitted voluntarily. As such, the use or interpretation of these data holdings is subject to significant limitations such as incomplete or biased reporting of adverse events and the extent to which the clinical details provided in reports are complete. All data that is extracted for external use is provided in the context of a caveat document explaining the limitations of the CARM dataset. The caveat document is available at: https://nzphvc.otago.ac.nz/wp-content/uploads/2014/08/NZPhvC Caveat.pdf.

The CARM database reports are received largely from health professionals and are therefore limited if patients do not tell their healthcare providers if they are taking NHPs. Additionally, many NHPs are bought online or at retail shops without a NHP practitioner consultation. This can result in adverse reactions that may go unreported, particularly as consumers are generally unaware of CARM and may not recognise that NHPs can cause adverse reactions.

Detecting the cause of adverse reactions is difficult. For example, there have been media reports on the difficulty in diagnosing vitamin B6 toxicity due to overconsumption of supplements, leading to misdiagnosis and considerable ill-health, including hospitalisation.

A copy of the data from 2018-2021 is attached to this letter as Document One.

Please note, some information has been withheld under the following sections of the Act:

- Section 9(2)(a) to protect the privacy of natural persons, and
- Section 9(2)(ba)(i) to protect information which is subject to an obligation of confidence and making it available would likely prejudice the supply of similar information from the same source.

I have considered the countervailing public interest in releasing the withheld information referred to above and consider that it does not outweigh the need to withhold at this time.

What evidence does the MOH have that demonstrates that Australian NHPs are safer than New Zealand NHPs?

What evidence does the MOH have that demonstrates that New Zealand NHPs are more hazardous than Australian NHPs?

Manatū Hauora does not hold any evidence that demonstrates that either Australian 'NHPs' are safer than New Zealand's or that New Zealand 'NHPs' are more hazardous than Australian 'NHPs'. The data held, as explained above and in caveat documents published with the data, cannot be used for comparative purposes.
