Response to your request for official information

Thank you for your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) to the Ministry of Health - Manatū Hauora (the Ministry) on 16 March 2024 for information regarding the Ministry's employment policies. You requested:

"Employment policy on employees with criminal convictions specifically assault Policy on gaining employment in high level senior advisory roles working on children's initiatives."

We do not hold this information as a policy; however, we can confirm that pre-employment checks for criminal convictions are mandatory for all positions with the Ministry of Health -Manatū Hauora. This applies to all employees including contractors.

Within our employment application forms we note that a false declaration about prior convictions or pending prosecutions will invalidate the application. If the candidate is the successful applicant, they will be required to undergo a Ministry of Justice check. Our employment offers are therefore conditional on the Ministry obtaining a satisfactory criminal record check which is stated in our letter of employment offer.

During this conditional period, the staff member may be restricted from completing certain duties. Should the criminal record check not be satisfactory, the staff member would be contacted, their employment would be reviewed, and their employment may come to an end.
