Your request for section 31(5) notifications relating to registered nurse coverage by provider/site is withheld in full under section 9(2)(ba)(i) of the Act, to protect information that is subject to an obligation of confidence and making it available would likely prejudice the supply of similar information, or information from the same source. I have considered the countervailing public interest in releasing information and consider that it does not outweigh the need to withhold at this time.

All documentation, briefings, and reports related to how the Healthy Ageing Team, Health Workforce Team and the Office of the Chief Nursing Officer for responding to these section 31 notifications respectively.

The Ministry has no documentations, briefing or reports within scope of this part of your request. Therefore, your request is refused under section 18(g)(i) of the Act, as the information is not held by the Ministry and there are no grounds for believing it is held by another agency subject to the Act.
